Please read below on the captain's responsibilities.

Before the games:

1. Please make sure everyone has paid his or hers \$25.
2. You must recruit nine members (ten-person team). To keep games fair, we highly encouraged every team to be co-ed.
3. Make sure everyone on your team arrives on time and registers with a JA staff member.
4. JA will be holding a split-the-pot raffle. If you or team members want to participate in split-the-pot, you must bring cash.
5. After registration, teams will be placed in their designated area. JA will make announcements on rules and other information.

During the games:

The bracketed events are 3 on 3 basketball, tug-of-war, kickball, fitness relay and volleyball. The team events are tournament-style, which means your team will be assigned a specific time to play. Your game time will be provided during registration. In order to avoid conflicts, as well as not spread a single teammate too thin, it is recommended that you limit team members to one of the four tournament-style events (basketball, tug-a-war, kickball, and fitness relay).
