Virtual **RECORDED VIDEO**

Record a video *anytime* from your home or office on your phone or computer.

1- to 2-hour commitment

In a short video (3-10 mins.), share:

Your expertise OR **Your career story** OR **JA content**

Virtual **REMOTE LIVE**

Through a LIVE stream video, you are virtually linked to a classroom of students.

2- to 7-hour commitment (depending on the program)

Beam in for one class session to share your story. OR **Lead an entire JA program series over several weeks.**
